Dear East Goscote Parish Council,

I am pleased to confirm that a site within your ownership 'The Dog Walk, East Goscote' has now been designated as a Local Wildlife Site, as discussed with you by Helen O'Brien.

Local Wildlife Sites comprise some of the best nature conservation sites within Leicestershire and Rutland. The status is 'non-statutory' – in other words it isn't protected by law and there is no legal obligation on you to manage or look after your site in any way, and it doesn't give anyone a right of access on to your land. Sites of Local Wildlife Site quality are taken into consideration when determining any development proposals. If your land meets Local Wildlife Site criteria it's an indication that is a good site for wildlife.
