STAFFING CHANGES

During 2024 we were sad to see our regular cleaner leave, and we wish her all the best for the future. In September we were pleased to appoint our new cleaner who has taken on both the regular and occasional cleaning roles. She is doing a fantastic job of continuing to maintain the hall to an excellent standard.

BOOKINGS AND REGULAR USERS

Towards the end of 2024 the Rainbows group had to be suspended, however we are hoping they will restart in the future and once again use the Village Hall.

The Guides and Brownies continue to meet during term time, and we have regular bookings for Radfield Day Centre and Align Yoga on Wednesdays. From November 2024 we have had Bizzy Bees Preschool using the hall on a weekly basis for a dance class.

During 2024 we had a total of 40 occasional bookings: including children's birthday parties, family get-togethers, a wake, valuation events, a physic night and the Rural Community Council offering advice and support on a variety of topics such as pension credit and how to keep warm during the colder months.

BUILDING MAINTENANCE WORKS

This year the kitchen has been repainted and retiled, with our records showing that during 2024 a total of £2,807.82 was invested in the building maintenance of the hall.

Thanks go to the volunteers who gave their time in helping with these refurbishments.

During 2025 we plan to replace the windows throughout the hall and are currently looking for grant funding towards this.

VILLAGE HALL ACTIVITIES

The Village Hall's social Table Tennis Club has continued to prove popular with a regular group of around 12 members and during the year were lucky enough to have a third table kindly donated to us. Following our successful grant application in 2023 we have continued to support the Let's Get Moving Campaign with 2 of the Table Tennis Club members joining them for the Loughborough Santa Fun Run in December! Thanks to Nick and Margaret for giving their time each week to run these sessions.

Our wonderful committee have worked hard to ensure the monthly Bingo Afternoons have gone from strength to strength, and it is lovely to see so many people attending each time. We have held themed sessions throughout the year including at Halloween and with Santa making an appearance at the Christmas special in December.

During 2024 the committee held scrabble and games afternoons, however due to low numbers these have unfortunately been unable to continue.
