BOOKINGS AND REGULAR USERS

The Guides and Brownies continue to meet during term time, and we have regular bookings for Radfield Day Centre and Align Yoga on Wednesdays. Bizzy Bees Preschool continue to use the hall on a regular basis for a dance class.

During 2025 we had a total of 38 occasional bookings: including children's birthday parties, family get-togethers, the year-6 leavers party, valuation events and children's activity days.

VILLAGE HALL ACTIVITIES

The Village Hall's social Table Tennis Club has continued to thrive, with a regular group of around 14 members enjoying both the game and the weekly camaraderie.

Our monthly Bingo Afternoons also continue to go from strength to strength, attracting an average of 28 attendees and raising just over £700 during 2025. We held several themed sessions throughout the year, including Halloween, and welcomed a visit from Santa at our Christmas special in December.

LET'S GET MOVING

In June 2025, we were delighted to receive New Age Kurling equipment and have since been running sessions on the 1st and 3rd Thursday of each month. Attendance has been slow to build, but in February 2026 we received a marketing grant from the Active Together Let's Get Moving campaign and are hopeful this will help the group to grow.

On Thursday 8th May 2025, the committee hosted a very successful Afternoon Tea in celebration of VE Day, welcoming 58 attendees and raising a fantastic £174.66 for the hall.

We also ran a one-off Children's Sports Day during August, giving young people the chance to try both table tennis and new age kurling. It was a lively, well-received event that brought plenty of smiles and enthusiasm to the hall.

The hall also organised CPR and Defibrillator training in partnership with the East Midlands Ambulance Service, with sessions held in September and February. These proved highly informative for everyone who attended.

These activities simply wouldn't be possible without the support of our fantastic committee. Our thanks go to Nick, Margaret and Rhonda for giving their time to ensure everything can run smoothly.

BUILDING MAINTENANCE WORKS

This year, new windows were installed throughout the hall, funded by grants from the National Lottery and the Parish Council.



Our records show that a total of £13,737.22 was invested in building maintenance during 2025, of which £12,770 came from grant funding.



We extend our thanks to the volunteers who generously gave their time to support these refurbishments.

Looking ahead to 2026, we hope to lower the ceiling to improve both heating efficiency and acoustics in the hall and are currently seeking grant funding to support this work.

ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING POINT

In February 2026, thanks to local government funding, the hall has had an EV charging point fitted. At a cost of 52p/kWh, this is available for all to use and can be accessed via the ROAM App.
