

SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL
(Streamleaze, Thornbury) (Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles, Pedal Cycles
and Equestrians) Order 2026

Notice is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended intends to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles, pedal cycles and equestrians the length of road specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this notice.

This order is required for the following reason: in connection with the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon Active Travel CRSTS works on or adjacent to the highway. The order will be operative from 2 November 2026 for a maximum period of eighteen months. The closure however may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only when traffic signs are in position and only for so long as is necessitated by the works. It is anticipated the works will be carried out between the hours of 8pm and 6am on the dates specified in column 2 of the said Schedule.

SCHEDULE

Column 1

Streamleaze – that length which extends from its junction with Rock Street to its junction with Tyndale View

Column 2

2 November 2026 – 7 November 2026
9 November 2026 – 14 November 2026
7 December 2026 – 12 December 2026

Alternative route: B4061, Grovesend Road, Gillingstool, Grovesend Road, Streamleaze (part unaffected) and vice versa.
